1. NOTICE AND QUORUM

The Chairperson noted that notice of the meeting and of the nature of the business to be conducted had been given to all members entitled to attend the meeting and a quorum was present.

2. DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST

For the purposes of Section 13A of the National Treasury Management Agency Act 1990 (as amended) and Section 17 of the Ethics in Public Office Act 1995, there were no material interests declared by members in the business to be transacted at the meeting.

3. COVID-19 UPDATE

The Chief Executive noted that the management team would provide an update to the Agency on the implications of Covid-19 for each of their respective areas. This is redacted pursuant to Section 40(1)(a) as it applies to 2(d) and Section 30(1)(b) and (c).

In relation to the NDFA, the Director outlined the broad impacts arising due to Covid-19, noting that 16 construction sites overseen by the NDFA had closed in line with Government Covid-19 measures

The Chief Financial and Operating Officer (CFOO) provided his update to the Agency noting the business operations were continuing as normal with a significant majority of staff working remotely. In relation to HR matters, the Director, HR reported that regular emails were being circulated to employees in addition to a weekly video from the Chief Executive to all staff. The HR department was also actively seeking to redeploy employees from certain teams to Business Units/Corporate Functions where the workload had increased substantially as a result of Covid-19.
